ICRDA History

The Iron County Resource Development Association, Inc. (ICRDA) was formed in 1963. The Industrial Park began in 1979 with an investment of over \$40,000 by the ICRDA and \$90,000 in grants. ICRDA has invested approximately \$400,000 for expansion of the Industrial Park along with spearheading \$2 million in grants, to accommodate additional industries. The ICRDA has provided seed money and staff time for many community development projects in Iron County. Loans or loan guarantees have been made to nine businesses in Hurley, Mercer, and Montreal for start-up or expansions.

The ICRDA is active in promoting business development, which includes business retention. In 1968 the National Guard was about to move its operation out of Hurley, but the ICRDA stepped in to build a new facility for them to lease in the Industrial Park. That facility is still leased today by the Army Reserve. The ICRDA pays approximately \$35,000 in property taxes annually.

Purpose

The purpose of the ICRDA is to promote development in Iron County through assistance in site development, financing, planning and working with local units of government. The ICRDA operates with a volunteer board of directors under Wisconsin's non-profit corporation law.


